***Annual Boat Registration Fee:** This is payable annually by all boat owning members. This one fee covers all boats you bring to the club.

Keys: A key for the club access gates is available for a deposit of **£10.** (refundable on return of key)

Mooring Fee: Set annually by the Crouch Harbour Authority **£172.20 per annum**

Cruiser moorings are administered by the Club Moorings Officer, on behalf of the Crouch Harbour Authority and may be rented on application. (If you require a mooring please also complete a Mooring Application Form which is available on request.
