Family: full sailing membership for spouse/partner and children/grandchildren up to the age of 18 or in full time education. (includes full voting rights at the AGM)

Single: full sailing membership for one individual. (includes full voting rights at the AGM)

Cadet: full sailing membership up to 18yrs of age or in full time education. Cadet Members are not required to pay a joining fee.

Associate memberships: Associate members are not required to pay a joining fee, but do not have voting rights at the AGM.

\*Annual Boat Registration Fee: This is payable annually by all boat owning members. This one fee covers all boats you bring to the club.

## Mooring Fee: Set annually by the Crouch Harbour Authority £ 179.94 per annum

Cruiser moorings are administered by the Club Moorings Officer, on behalf of the Crouch Harbour Authority and may be rented on application. If you require a mooring please also complete a Mooring Application Form which is available on request.

Crouch Harbour Authority Plaque Fees (a plaque is issued on payment of Harbour Dues) should be made directly to the Crouch Harbour Authority either on-line or by telephone.

### Launch and Recovery Syndicate Membership

For cruiser members who wish to make use of this facility there is a one off payment of £448-00

This entitles you to launch & recover your cruiser with the help of the syndicate and its equipment without further payment for the duration of your membership

#### **Work Party Information**

There are four club work parties per year and all full sailing members must attend at least one of these.

<u>In addition</u> to the club work parties there is a Dinghy Park work party which <u>all dinghy owners</u> must attend. Those who do not attend will be required to do an additional duty.

There are also two Launch and Recovery work parties per year, one of which must be attended by all Cruiser members who join the Launch & Recovery Syndicate. Full details are in the club rule book, which can be viewed on the club website.
